The Indianapolis Airport is about 50 miles from Bloomington. Below are some options to get from the airport to the IU campus. These are the current prices but they are not guaranteed.

The two shuttle services are comparable in price but they leave the airport every two hours, so depending on the flight arrival time, there can be some wait.
